### Lacrosse Clinic in P.E.



On October 19<sup>th</sup>, the Roswell Parks and Recreation Department Youth Lacrosse Board of Directors will donate one hundred lacrosse sticks to our school. In addition, students in grades third through fifth grades will participate in a "mini clinic" during their P.E. class. The "mini clinic" will include: watching a short DVD "This is Lacrosse". The video gives students a visual of the game, explains the object of the game, and provides insight to the differences between the girls and boys lacrosse game. The students will learn the history of lacrosse and the history of lacrosse in Georgia, and see a demonstration of skills (passing, catching, cradling, scooping, dodging, and shooting). The students will then be divided into stations to practice the skills taught. Lacrosse will become a part of our unit plans in an effort to encourage children to participate in this exciting and growing sport.
