ILLNESS



If your child visits a doctor, please send a note to the teacher. If you keep your child home, please send in a note stating the cause. Parents are allowed up to ten home-generated sick notes, after which they are expected to send in doctor-generated sick notes.

Please follow these guidelines when your child is ill:

1. Do not send your child to school unless he/she has been without a fever for 24 hours.
2. If your child complains about an upset stomach, stomachache, or nausea, please consider with whom he/she may have come in contact, especially during flu season.
3. Please make sure your child has some breakfast before coming to school. Many stomachaches are a result of not having had breakfast.
4. Please notify the school office if your child had a contagious disease or an extended illness.

EMERGENCY DRILLS

Parents, did you know that Northwood Elementary conducts regular safety drills? So far this year, we have had four fire drills, one intruder drill, one tornado drill, and one bomb drill. Our students have maintained silence and participated in these drills in an exemplary manner.
